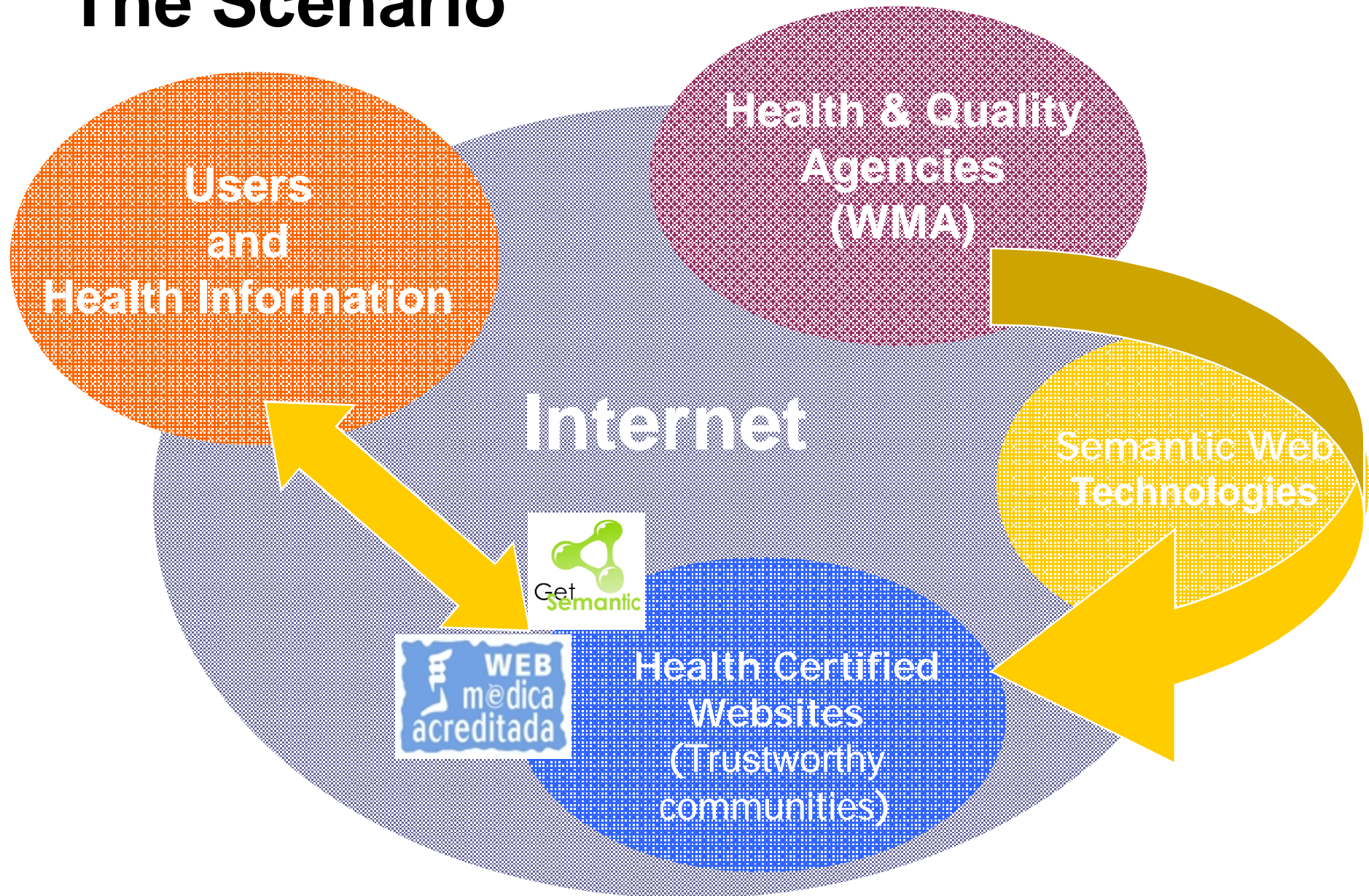

Web Mèdica Acreditada

- n Quality Programme launched in 1999 by the Medical Council of Barcelona (COMB), Spain.
- n **Non-profit** and professional organization.
- n More than 1,100 organizations have requested the accreditation, focused in websites where **medical doctors** are involved (in Spanish and Catalan).
- n Near than 600 “domain names” in Spain and Latin America are certified (more than 200 in process), around 20,000 web pages in a “WMA Portal” (Google Customize Search Engine).
- n Developing **Semantic Web** technologies since 2002 (MedCIRCLE EU project).

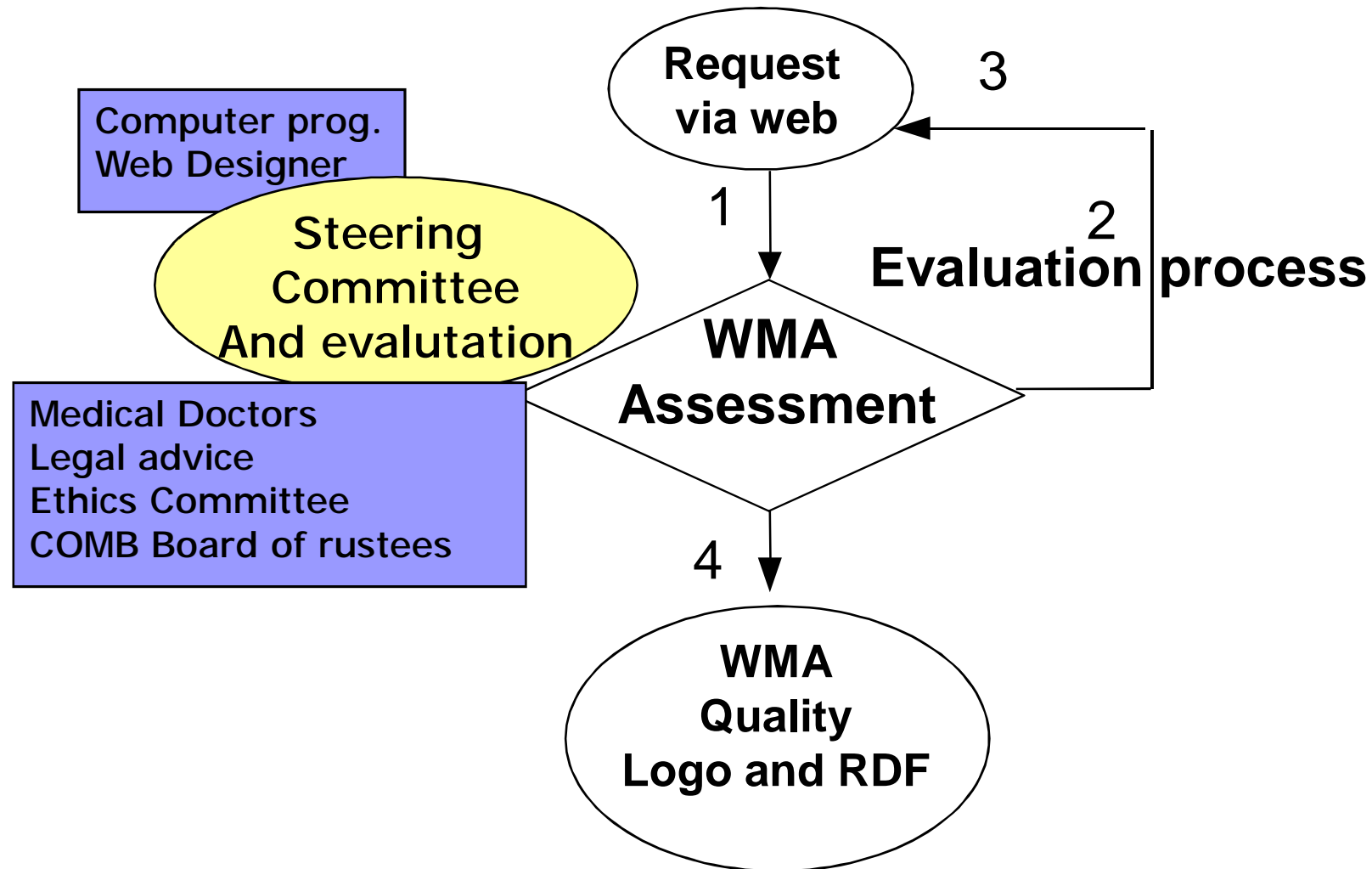

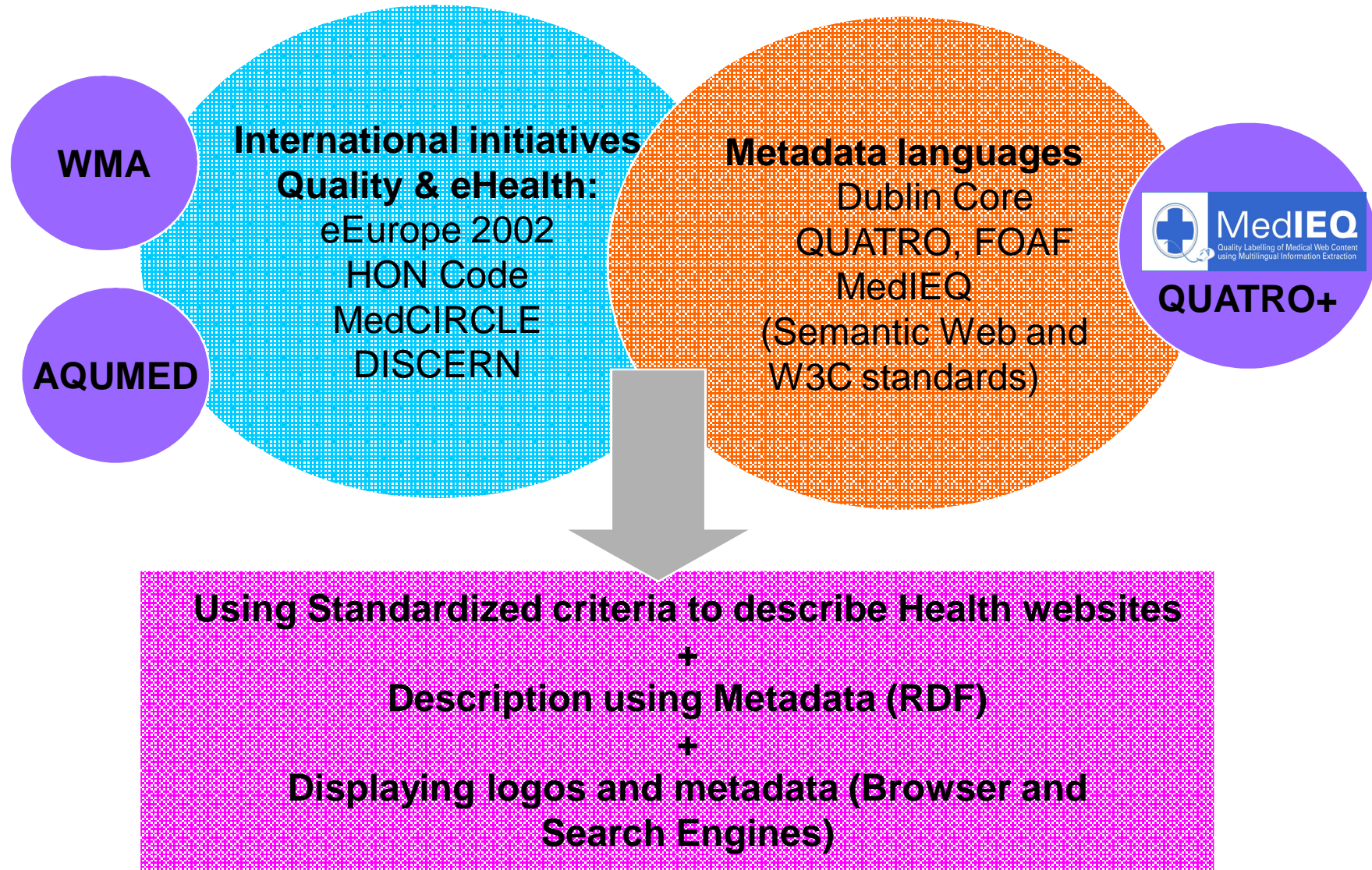

- n Integrating several tools in a platform efficiently and in a flexible way (semantic web and multilingual extraction tools):
 - .. Simplifying rating and labelling processes.
 - .. Monitoring medical certified websites.
 - .. Generating RDF files automatically.
 - .. Customizing the set of criteria according to needs and changes.
 - .. To be prepared for next Search Engines generation based on Semantic Web.
